

## Center for Male Engagement 2012 Summer Programs

The Community College of Philadelphia announces the 2012 Center for Male Engagement Summer Programs. These free programs, geared towards African American males, provide participants who intend to enter the Community College of Philadelphia for the first time in Fall 2012 with an orientation to College and community resources as well as the opportunity to become engaged in the life of the College prior to the larger College population arriving on campus. Students who successfully complete the program will automatically become a member of the Community College of Philadelphia's Center for Male Engagement. Through the Center, participants will be assigned a Support Coach who will assist with challenging personal needs in addition to providing encouragement to take advantage of the many academic and social opportunities at the College.

### About the Summer Programs

The Center for Male Engagement offers a two-week and three-week summer program each with two program date options. Each program includes either a two-day or four-day mandatory overnight, off campus leadership development retreat where food, lodging and transportation will be provided. These programs will bring together recent high school graduates and returning adult students to ease the transition into the college setting. Please rank your program and program date preferences on the application. First choice selections of programs and program dates will be accommodated as best as possible, but cannot be guaranteed.

### What Can I Expect?

- Presentations on topics such as academic success strategies, career development, communication, dressing for success, leadership, male growth and development, managing your money, and time management.
- A weekly SEPTA TransPass to provide transportation to the campus as well as lunch daily.
- A stipend upon successful completion of the program.
